Catch the public bus to the nearby market town for some pub grub and a potter around the shops. Meet at the bus stop near the entrance to CenterParcs and return when you like.

#### 1230 Light Lunch

Cheese or beans on toast available in the Party Lodge if you're peckish after your swim.

#### 1400 Fun & Games

Challenge your newfound friends to a variety of games - classic, retro and modern - whilst sitting around a cosy log fire. Feel free to bring your favourite game along.

#### 1530 Liqueur Tasting

Ahead of tonight's party there's the chance to sample a range of drinks and liqueurs from around the world. Ever tried Brazilian ciapirinha, Icelandic schnapps or Thai rum?

#### 1700 Dinner Buffet

Fill your plate with vegetable curry and rice or pizza and salads. Plus a selection of desserts. Ends at 1930.

### 2030 "Around The World" Party

## About Our Event...

It's a simple premise: we take over the best area of the best CenterParcs village, throw parties each night, with a help-yourself bar included, and enjoy the nearby Lake District or the on-site subtropical swimming paradise and other activities during the daytime.

We and our friends have been doing this since the CenterParcs village opened near Penrith around 15 years ago, and we've refined it so there's a full weekend programme of activities hiking, quizzes, fancy dress parties, tastings, country pub lunches - and a package of meals and bar all included. By necessity our catering isn't posh nosh - we use one of the woodland lodges as our base for the weekend, so feeding 70+ people can be a challenge but then we also hit the cash & carry to provide an all-inclusive bar throughout the weekend so you've pretty much nothing else to pay.

The event is open to anyone who wants to come and make friends. In the beginning the event was for the Mensa social club but over the years people have invited friends, and they've invited friends, so now it is just a random group of people. Each year we welcome many new faces who often return with their own friends the following year. What better recommendation!

We've limited capacity and usually sell out some months in advance, so book soon!

## Sunday

#### 0730 Remembrance Sunday Hike - Great Gable

Take part in this special annual event, a hike up one of Lakeland's finest mountains for the 11am remembrance service. It is a simple ceremony of remembrance for those who fell for our freedom, and is not religious, nationalist or militaristic. A fantastic walk in good conditions, but if the forecast is for extreme weather we will not set out! The walk climbs 1600ft in about 3 miles to Green Gable on the NW slopes of Grey Knotts and Brandreth and is mercilessly exposed to any weather. From Green Gable there is a stiff 150ft descent to Windy Gap (an appropriate name) before the stiffer 300ft climb with some easy scrambling to the summit of Great Gable. Then after the ceremony it is all to be reversed. A strenuous 7 mile mountain excursion with 2200ft of ascent and redescent but no major technical difficulties. You'll need hiking boots, waterproof, overtrousers, warm clothing, headwear (hood, balaclava), gloves, packed lunch, emergency rations and something non-alcoholic to drink. If you have them you should also bring map, compass, whistle, headtorch, trekking poles, GPS. Led by Stephen Nelson, there will be a briefing and kit check in Stephen's lodge on Saturday at 1700.

#### From 0900 Outdoor Pursuits

## The Small Print

#### The Package

Our CenterParcs weekend break is Friday 9th to Monday 12th November 2012 at the Whinfell Forest resort, including 3 nights accommodation in a lodge sharing a twin-bedded room. Each night will feature a party in our Party Lodge with full bar included while stocks last - but we've never run out! Buffet meals and events programme as per this brochure. Prices are for the complete package as described, except items such as pub lunches are pay-as-you-go. Off-site events require use of your own transport or car share. If you're a couple we have some double rooms at no extra cost. A limited number of en-suite double rooms are available at a supplement of £30 per room.

#### Accommodation

We've booked lovely two-storey newly refurbished lodges close together in a forest setting only a few minutes walk from the main CenterParcs dome. Each lodge sleeps 6 or 8 people. You'll get a place in a twin room - or double room on request - and if travelling alone we'll find you a sharer of the same sex. Or there's the option to pay a supplement for a room to yourself. Each well-equipped lodge has 3 or 4 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, separate toilet, and open plan lounge, dining room and kitchen. Bed linen and towels are provided

#### **Terms Of Booking**

The event is run by Maruba Events and guests are subject to CenterParcs terms and conditions as per their brochure. We'll endeavour to run the advertised programme but circumstances change so we reserve the right to vary the programme as deemed necessary. All accommodation is non-smoking including the vicinity of the Party Lodge. We reserve the right to refuse bookings. We book a mix of accommodation many months in advance, so while we'll do our best to fulfil requests for styles, upgrades and people to share with, we can make no guarantees of this. Bookings for under 18s are at the discretion of the organisers and in the event that we accept such a booking we require that their accompanying adult provide full supervision. #### FAQ

Is it for singles?

It's for individuals, couples and groups of friends. There's a very friendly and relaxed atmosphere making it easy to make new friends.

#### Will everyone know each other?

Some will, but many people are new. Some of these will know the friend who brought them along; others will know nobody and are jumping in at the deep end. Everyone is made very welcome.

#### Can we bring children?

The event is primarily for adults but we will do our best to accommodate families. We don't put under 18s in a lodge without checking with all concerned. If you want to bring your children please talk to us. There is a discount for under 18s as children will not be able to participate in all activities on the programme.

#### What's the age range?

Typically from mid-20s through to mid-50s, though we've had guests aged 8 months to 80 years.

#### I'm a fussy eater ...?

Our meals are buffet style so you can select what you like. They feature plenty of vegetarian choices. Due to limited kitchen facilities we're unable to provide any special individual meals though will do our best to cater for food allergies if notified in advance.

#### How easy is travel to the resort?

By car it's five minutes off the M6 at junction 40 or by train it's near the West Coast Main Line station at Penrith. Taxis from the station typically cost £10-£15. We'll send you full travel information before the weekend.
